



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
SITE LOCATION TOPOGRAPHIC MAP





1-MILE RADIUS STREET MAP W/OCCURENCES







RCRA tightly regulates all hazardous waste from "cradle to grave." RCRA also controls garbage and industrial waste. Common garbage is municipal waste, which consists mainly of paper, yard trimmings, glass, and other materials. Industrial waste is process waste that comes from a broad range of operations.
